Articles of Continuance (transition)

6. Statement of the purposes of the Corporation

- a) To advance the teachings of Soka Gakkai Nichiren Buddhism and the religious tenets, doctrines, observances and culture associated therewith, all in accordance with the Statement of Faith of the Corporation.
- b) To establish, coordinate, operate and regulate the activities of local district meetings across Canada in order to strengthen the spiritual welfare of practitioners of Soka Gakkai Nichiren Buddhism in Canada.
- c) To train spiritual leaders in accordance with the teachings of Soka Gakkai Nichiren Buddhism, to full-time and part-time service, as well as to regulate and guide their activities in furtherance of the purposes herein.
- d) To advance Soka Gakkai Nichiren Buddhism by establishing, maintaining and operating one or more retreat centres or conference centres to be used for religious retreats, seminars, conferences, workshop and programs in furtherance of the purposes herein all in accordance with the Statement of Faith for SGI Canada;
- e) To advance Soka Gakkai Nichiren Buddhism by conducting meetings, discussions, seminars, conferences, workshops, public art exhibitions, presentations, performance arts events, and symposia for individuals, groups and organizations to further the purposes of SGI Canada.
- f) To establish, maintain and operate burial grounds and cemeteries for practitioners of Soka Gakkai Nichiren Buddhism.
